His teachings revolved around three core principles: equality, compassion and faith. He also blessed us with 3 golden rules: Naam Japna (meditate), Kirat Karni (work hard) and Vand ke Shakna (share with others).

Sikhs around the world celebrate his birth anniversary, known as GURPURAB. It is a time for Sikhs to come together, reflect on Guru Nanak Dev Ji's teachings and celebrate his Life and Legacy.
